#### **Philly Loves Saint John's**

By nature, our clients are more at risk of viruses and diseases, especially during citywide flare-ups. To protect our residents, Saint John's has partnered with the City's Homeless Services and The Department of Public Health to provide vaccinations. Since March, they have visited a total of 7 times to distribute Covid-19 vaccinations and boosters. This September, the partnership set up a vaccination clinic in our brand-new Connelly Dining Room to give our residents the chance to get their free Monkey Pox vaccine. By the time you're reading this, they would have visited for a second time this year!









Every day at 10 pm, Saint John's provides emergency overnight shelter in our yard, as a part of our coffee house program. Previously, this yard was nothing but an empty cement rectangle but thanks to your generous spirit and continuous support, we have been able to transform this space by adding black metal bunk beds, housing 30 beds in total. This doesn't just give our clients a safe place to stay for the night, away from the extreme weather of each season, but gives them the opportunity for a good night's rest. Because of donors like you, our men get a bed to themselves for the night, furthering our mission of helping individuals experiencing homelessness find dignity, respect, and a new beginning.
